

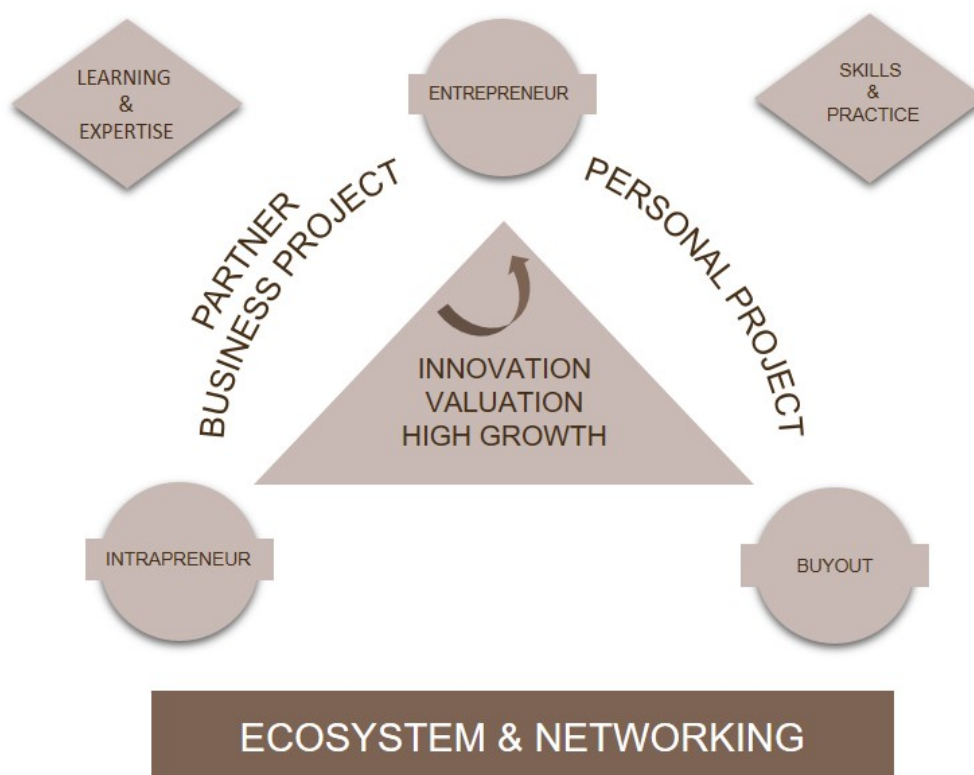


OVERVIEW
